PRICING* (FOR THE FULL WEEKEND!)

Activities & Food

Adults: \$370 per person

Child (3 – 12 years): \$290 per person

Children 2 years & younger: Free

Lodging (Pictures on next page)

Private Cabin: \$625 per family

There are several cabin villages with a variety of amenities and all within a short walk to the heart of camp. Each private accommodation is ½ of a cabin that sleeps up to 8 people. Each suite includes four sets of bunk beds with one private bathroom. All cabins include A/C and heat.

The Lodge: \$740 per family

The Lodge is a brand new upscale, hotel-style building with 28 rooms that sleep up to 4 people each. Each room has 2 queen beds and a private bathroom, mini fridge, microwave and Keurig coffee maker and a private small outdoor seating area.

Shared Housing

If you would like to share either housing option with another family, lodging costs can be divided evenly between parties.

Calculate your weekend cost:

Adults x \$370 + # Children x \$290 + Housing Option = Weekend Total

Example costs for 2 adults and 1 child in a private cabin:

2 Adults x \$370 = \$740

1 Child x \$290 = \$290

1 Cabin x \$625 = \$625

Weekend Total = \$1655 (includes lodging, food, and all activities!)

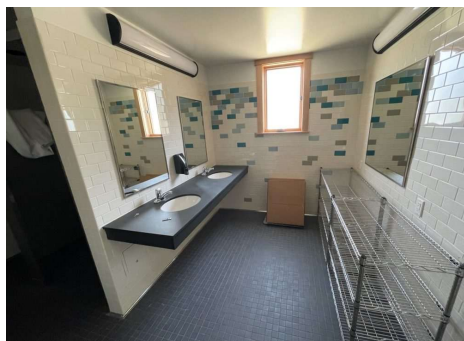
